6.1 Competition Events

Including Optional and compulsory routines of Changquan, Nanquan, Taijiquan, Daoshu, Jianshu, Nandao, Taijijian, Gunshu, Qiangshu and Nangun.

6.2 Traditional Events

Including different kinds of traditional barehanded and traditional apparatus routines. The compulsory and traditional routines of Chen, Yang, Wú, Wu and Sun Style Taijiquan.

6.3 Dual Events

Bare-handed vs. bare-handed, bare-handed vs. weapons, weapons vs. weapons.

6.4 Group Events

Barehanded group events, group events with apparatus.

7. Participation Methods

- 7.1 All the Wushu associations, organizations or schools throughout the world and fans in wushu may get in their entries individually or by forming teams.
- 7.2 Each team may enter 1 team leader and 2 coach; 1 judge the number of athletes is not limited.
- 7.3 Each participating athlete may enter at most 1 bare-handed routine and 1 apparatus routine. He/she may enter for dual events and group events.
- 7.4 For group events, each participating team should have at least 3 people.

8. Competition Methods

8.1 The competition shall adopt the "Wushu Competition Rules of Taolu" (2005) endorsed by the Chinese Wushu Association.

8.2 Time limit:

- 8.2.1 Bare-handed and apparatus routines of both competition and traditional events shall be less than 2 minutes (except Taijiquan category).
- 8.2.2 For the competition events, 24 forms Taijiquan, 42 forms Taijijian shall be in 4-5 minutes; 42 forms Taijiquan shall be in 5-6 minutes; 32 forms Taijijian and optional Taijijian shall be in 3-4 minutes.

- 8.2.3 Traditional Taiji shall be less than 4 minutes. The head judge will blow a whistle when the athlete performs to 3 minutes.
- 8.2.4 Dual event shall last at least 40 seconds.
- 8.2.6 Group event shall be less than 4 minutes. Music should be accompanied to the routine. (CD shall be brought by the participating teams.) No lyrics are allowed, otherwise, 0.1 point will be deducted by the head judge. 0.1 point will be deducted if a group performs without music.

8.3 Age groups:

Group A: below age 9 (Born after January 1, 2011)

Group B: age 9 -12 (Born between January 1, 2008 and December 31, 2010)

Group C: age 13 - 15 (Born between January 1, 2005 and December 31, 2007)

Group D: age 16 – 18 (Born between January 1, 2002 and December 31, 2005)

Group E: age 19 – 44 (Born between January 1, 2001 and December 31, 1974)

Group F: age 45-60 (Born between January 1, 1975 and December 31,1960)

Group G above age 60

9. Placing and Awards

- 9.1 Medal and Certificate will be awarded to the Top 3 place winners in the individual or dual event for both male and female according to age groups. The other competitors will be conferred certificate of participation.
- 9.2 Trophy and Certificate will be awarded to the Top 3 place of the participating teams in the group event. The other participating teams will be conferred certificate of participation.
- 9.3 For any individual events, if the number of participants is less than 3 people, those participants will be grouped into the Other Barehanded Routines or Other Apparatus Routines categories.
- 9.4 For any dual events, if the number of participants is less than 3 people, those participants will be grouped into the nearest age group.
- 9.5 For those associations, organizations or schools which had 20 or more people participated in this tournament, Trophy and Certificate of "The World Wushu Development Contribution Award" will be awarded.

10. Entry and Registration

- 10.1 TWO hard copies of registration form and related documents should be printed out, one should be kept and took by your team to the Tournament for check by the Organizing Committee, the other should be sent to the Organizing Committee of the German Wushu International Championship before 31th May, 2019. A soft copy of registration form and related documents should be sent by email to haojun_zhuo@hotmail.com.
- 10.2 Each athlete should submit a recent passport photo, a copy of passport, a copy of Liability Exemption (Annex 2) to the Organizing Committee of the German Wushu International Tournament.

11. Jury of Appeal and Officials

Candidates of the Jury of Appeal and Officials will be selected and informed by Deutsche Wushu Federation in due course.
